

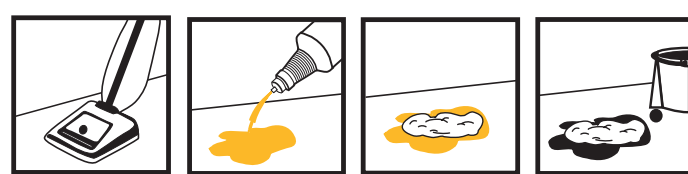


# Carpet Cleaning Program

## ROUTINE



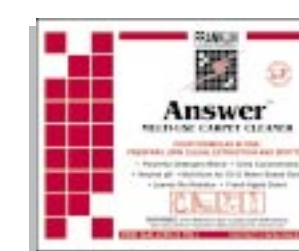
### VACUUM AND SPOT REMOVAL



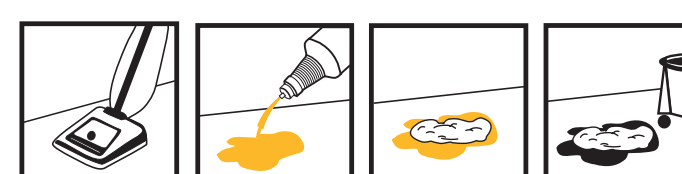
1. VACUUM 2. APPLY 3. BLOT 4. RINSE

1. **VACUUM** area thoroughly before applying cleaners.
2. **APPLY** spotter to the outer edges of the spot first and then on the spot or stain. Do not over-wet.
3. **BLOT** using a clean white cloth.
4. **RINSE & BLOT** using clean water and a clean white cloth. **REPEAT** steps 2 through 3 if necessary.

## RESTORATION



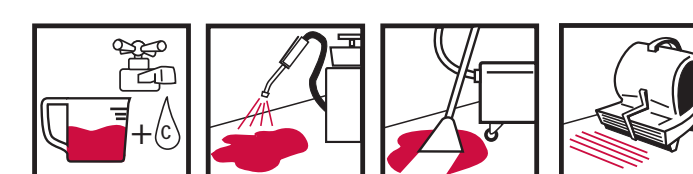
### VACUUM AND SPOT REMOVAL



1. VACUUM 2. APPLY 3. BLOT 4. RINSE

1. **VACUUM** area thoroughly before applying cleaners.
2. **APPLY** spotter to the outer edges of the spot first and then on the spot or stain. Do not over-wet.
3. **BLOT** using a clean white cloth.
4. **RINSE & BLOT** using clean water and a clean white cloth. **REPEAT** steps 2 through 3 if necessary.

### PRESPRAY AND EXTRACTION



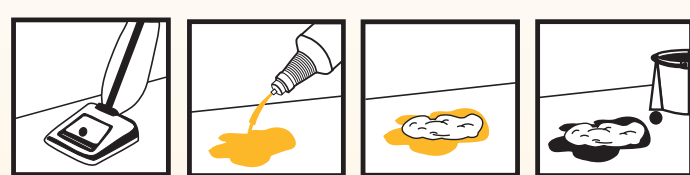
1. DILUTE 2. SPRAY 3. EXTRACT 4. DRY

1. **DILUTE** product according to label directions.
2. **PRESPRAY** the carpet using a tank sprayer or electric sprayer. Allow a 15 minute dwell time for maximum results.
3. **EXTRACT**
4. **FORCE DRY**

## INTERIM



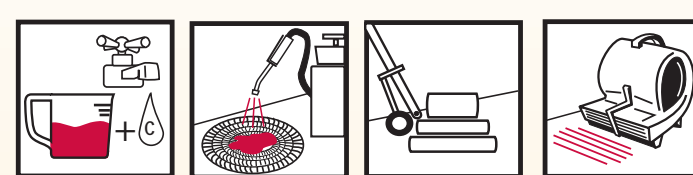
### VACUUM AND SPOT REMOVAL



1. VACUUM 2. APPLY 3. BLOT 4. RINSE

1. **VACUUM** area thoroughly before applying cleaners.
2. **APPLY** spotter to the outer edges of the spot first and then on the spot or stain. Do not over-wet.
3. **BLOT** using a clean white cloth.
4. **RINSE & BLOT** using clean water and a clean white cloth. **REPEAT** steps 2 through 3 if necessary.

### PRESPRAY AND BONNET CLEAN



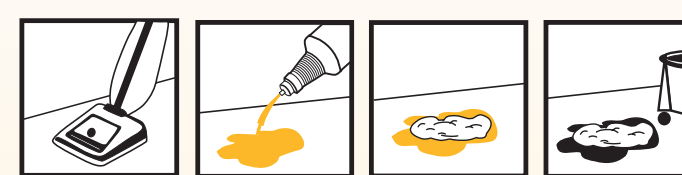
1. DILUTE 2. SPRAY 3. BONNET 4. DRY

1. **DILUTE** product according to label directions.
2. **PRESPRAY** or treat the bonnet and carpet.
3. **SPIN BONNET** using a low speed rotary machine and appropriate driver.
4. **FORCE DRY**

## SPOT REMOVAL



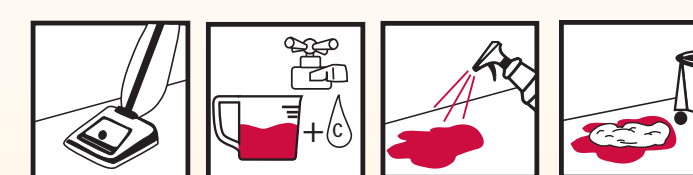
### ALL PURPOSE SPOT REMOVAL



1. VACUUM 2. APPLY 3. BLOT 4. RINSE

1. **VACUUM** area thoroughly before applying cleaners.
2. **APPLY** spotter to the outer edges of the spot first and then on the spot or stain. Do not over-wet.
3. **BLOT** using a clean white cloth.
4. **RINSE & BLOT** using clean water and a clean white cloth. **REPEAT** steps 2 through 3 if necessary.

### ALKALINE STAIN REMOVAL



1. VACUUM 2. DILUTE 3. SPRAY 4. RINSE

1. **VACUUM** area thoroughly before applying cleaners.
2. **DILUTE** product according to label directions.
3. **SPRAY** the outer edges of the stain first, then center of stain.
4. **BLOT & RINSE:** Blot with a clean cloth and rinse with clean water, then repeat blotting.
